

BEING FRANK ON FOOTBALL

I think very few discerning football lovers would begrudge Liverpool the Premier League title. After last season's near miss, when they accumulated 97 points and just one narrow defeat to the former Champions, Manchester City, this was a case of justice seen to be done.

They finished on 99 points, which was not quite enough to eclipse that City title triumph when they ended on 101, but it was a gallant effort nonetheless.

Andrew Robertson's assist for Divock Origi's strike in their final encounter against Newcastle United, was his 12th of the season in the Premier League, surpassing his 11 for last season, with only team-mate Trent Alexander-Arnold providing more assists in a Premier League season as a defender, notching up 13 in total.

But the Reds have turned into record breakers in a number of different ways. Liverpool won away for the 14th time in this season's Premier League, which incidentally is another new club record! Liverpool have remained unbeaten at Anfield in three consecutive league seasons, which is also a notable first! But it is probably in attack where they have possibly excelled the most. The three musketeers up front seem to be always getting on the score-sheet and in Sadio Mane, Roberto Firmino and the irrepressible Mo Salah, they are a delight to watch and have played by far the most entertaining football in this stop-start Premier League season. And let's not forget Dutch import Virgil Van Dyke, who waded in with five goals of his own!

At the bottom of the table, I was sorry to see Bournemouth go down. They won their last match at Everton 1-3, but it was too little too late and Aston Villa were spared the fate of Watford and Norwich too, in returning from

whence they came. The Cherries stayed in the top flight against all odds for 5 seasons, and manager Eddie Howe has always tried to play exciting football.

Leicester City, under Brendan Rodgers, looked to have secured a Champions League spot months ago but this Corona virus interval did them no favours at all, and they fell away badly in the end, losing out to Manchester United and Chelsea on the final day.

In the Championship, Leeds United got the first automatic promotion place and will now join the elite league thanks in the main to the inspirational influence of their head coach Marcelo Bielsa! It was their first trophy for 28 years, but they had to celebrate it at an empty Elland Road. West Bromwich Albion pipped Brentford for the second automatic place.

In Spain, Real Madrid were victorious, winning La Liga by a decisive five points. Lionel Messi is said to be frustrated at Barcelona but is unlikely to throw in the towel.

I shall end on my thoughts on the Premier Prediction League. With one game to go, I was leading but Burnley and Everton both losing at home cost me dearly and I ended up losing four points, as my direct hits decreased in the process. I quickly realised I could no longer win it but I did, however, do a lot better than the 22 football pundits on the Beeb, as none of them managed to predict the top three in the right order, and although Ruud Gullit got the top four, they were all the wrong way around!
