



The Citizens look unstoppable right now, but they must tighten up at the back. They took their foot off the gas unwisely, and a rejuvenated Red Devils side took full

advantage of it with two goals from Martial, and a superb strike from former Ajax forward Anthony early on.

Putting things into perspective however, the stats don't lie. City had 22 shots on goal to United's 12, and ten of those were on target! That was the big difference in the end, but nobody would deny The Citizen's strength in depth, as Foden and Haaland took home the match balls, having both scored impressive hat-tricks.

Amazingly, after all that, Arsenal are still top of the tree by a point, after continuing their excellent start to the season with a commanding 3-1 victory over Tottenham in another fascinating local derby. The Gunners have made an excellent start to their Premier League season, and whilst Spurs have started well too, they were a pale shadow of their former selves at the Emirates. Spanish manager Mikel Arteta said afterwards, "They were phenomenal. We went for it, and we created great energy in the stadium, and deserved to win the game."

Liverpool by contrast are really struggling. Two more dropped points against Brighton

in a riveting 3-3 draw at Anfield did not help them - although they battled back from a two-goal deficit to take a 3-2 lead, before Belgium forward Leandro Trossard scored his hat-trick!

The Seagull's new wave Italian boss Roberto De Zerbi has certainly started with a bang, and his side played some wonderful football on his first visit to Merseyside. He has identified 28-year-old Solly March as a key member of his squad, and his modernistic approach to football strategies is already beginning to bear some fruit. After the sudden departure of Graham Potter to Chelsea, Brighton fans could not have expected much from this game, but they thoroughly deserved their point.

At the foot of the table, The Foxes have started really badly, and manager Brendan Rodgers must be nervously looking over his shoulder as Wolves have just parted company with their head coach Bruno Lage. It was no surprise, as they had won just once and lost nine of their last 15 Premier games under his stewardship.

Everton have improved considerably since I last wrote and have now gone six games without defeat, moving to eleventh in the table. The fixtures have been rather kind to them recently however, and I think their boss Frank Lampard will have his work cut out to keep them safe.
